The Center for the Treatment of Sexual Assault Victims is a multidisciplinary center for treating sexual assault victims and potentially sexually assaulted patients, established in 2001 and recognized by the Ministry of Health.

The patients receive medial and psychosocial assistance in a professional and discrete manner, and benefit from a kind, supportive and secure environment.

The Center serves the entire Northern population, and treats young children, men, and women of all ages and sectors.

Treatment includes:

- ✓ Comprehensive medical examination.
- ✓ Pharmacological treatment.
- ✓ Evaluation of the victim's and the family's needs,
- as well as support and reference for continued treatment and rehabilitation within the community.
- ✓ Short term Psychosocial treatment for the victim and the family.
- \checkmark Documentation of findings for legal proceedings.
- ✓ Submission of evidence and medical opinion to a court of law.







The Center's staff includes: a gynecologist, a colorectal surgeon, a pediatrician, a social worker, nurses, medical clown care, a secretary, and volunteers. The staff members underwent a unique training program for the treatment of sexual assault victims and providing solutions customized professionally for the patients.

The Center works to raise the public awareness to sexual offenses, locating them and finding ways of prevention in a variety of ways: training and activities in the community for the prevention and detection of sexual exploitation and sexual assault cases, meetings and tours with the hospital staff, consultants in schools, social services, children and youth interrogators, women's organizations and the like.
